We offer the full spectrum of Overhead environment courses. Starting with a cave “preparation course” (Overhead Protocols) all the way to Technical Cave (TECH CAVE). Because of the experience of our instructors but also due to the morphology of the Caves we teach in, the student is not having a “sample” of how it feels to be in a Cave but is enjoying a proper “preview” of what is waiting for him as future Cave diver. Proper conditions, safety, but also amazing formations and passages. Exactly how a Cave course should be. Always safe, but in true conditions. The course is not only focused on making sure the Cave diver can handle failures and follows proper protocols, but also to give him/her the chance to see for himself if is trully what he is looking for as far as diving goes.

CAVE #1 COURSE

COURSE INFORMATION

This is a preparatory course for the diver who wants to start his/hers path towards any type of overhead diving. During the first part of this course the diver will be able to properly plan a “simulation” cave dive, deploy a reel and connect the “surface” to the cave’s main guideline, and navigate on it following proper procedures and protocols while in an open water environment to maximize safety. Then he/she will be able to dive safely in a cavern using the techniques learned in open water, with additional failures, gas sharing, and no visibility drills. The cavern course introduces the diver to the ideal equipment configuration, but it can be done with or without double cylinders. The main theoretical elements taught in this course include equipment, basic navigation, problem solving and safety in the overhead environment.

In this course, all navigation, gas management and dive plan protocols will be taught and the diver will be introduced to all procedures, safety, equipment and in depth details that will allow him/her to dive safely within his/her limits of existing certifications, in the overhead environment. It's the first time also that the future cave diver will get an idea of the importance of how his/hers physical but mostly psychological conditions affect the dive due to the actual inability to quit the dive and directly ascend.
